Biblical Correction

- 1. Begin biblical correction by first training rightly. (2 Tim 3:14-17)**
- 2. Evaluate each situation to see what level of correction is required (2 Sam 12:1-10)**
- 3. Enter into use of the rod with a heart of restoration and not of vengeance (Rom 12:19; Luke 6:42)**
- 4. Use of the rod should only be used with verbal correction (Pro 19:27)**
- 5. Use of the rod should be followed by love and grace (1 John 1:9; Prov 3:11-12)**

6. How should parents discipline their child using the rod?

- **Faithfully** (Heb 12:5-11; Prov 3:11-12; 1 Cor 1:9)
- **Carefully** (Prov 13:24; 23:13; 29:15; Eph 6:4)
- **Immediately/Urgently** (Prov 13:24)
- **Lovingly** (Prov 13:24; Eph 6:4)
- **Wisely** (Prov 1:8; 2:16; 3:1; 4:14, 14:15, 20:27; 29:15)
- **Painfully** (Prov 23:13; Eph 6:1; Col 3:20)
- **Obediently** (Prov 19:18)
- **Expectantly** (Prov 19:18; 22:15,17)
